Equipping Minds Colored House Cards Instructions

Cognitive Skill: visual processing, working memory, attention long-term memory, visual memory, auditory memory

Challenges: You can use the cards to learn the Equipping Minds NBack Code in the Equipping Minds Cognitive Development Curriculum (EMCDC) page 39-43. Build on learning one element at a time such as the color, then the animal, symbol, number, letter, president, month, vowel, and directions by turn the house up, down, left and right. The student will learn all of the elements on the cards and show the connection to the animal page, 1-5 and 1-9 number hunt, A-I Letter Fluency, vowel page, presidents, and directions in the EMCDC.

Materials: Print the cards and laminate or place in a small sheet protector.

Print the Equipping Minds NBack Guide Sheet- Make two copies and laminate one and cut the individual elements as game pieces. Use can also use colored cubes, uno cards 1-9 or any 1-9 cards, as well as the individual elements: colored square, number, symbol, animal picture with word, president picture, letter, vowel, month
