1. Why Cognitive Training?

Most struggling learners are not missing academic content; they are missing the cognitive foundations that make content learnable. Working memory, processing speed, auditory and visual processing, attention, and cognitive flexibility are the skills that allow a student to hold information, connect ideas, and transfer learning across subjects.

Equipping Minds Cognitive Development Curriculum (EMCDC) was developed by Dr. Carol T. Brown, Ed.D., to directly strengthen these underlying cognitive skills, not through tutoring, but through structured, intensive cognitive training. Independent research conducted at the University of North Alabama, Boyce College, and Dallas Theological Seminary confirms measurable cognitive and academic gains among students aged 9–68, with and without learning disabilities.

★ **What Research Shows**

In a 2025 public school study at the University of North Alabama, students with SLD and ADHD who received EMCDC training gained +48 scaled score points in iReady Reading and +34 in iReady Math in just 8 weeks — compared to near-zero gains in the control group receiving regular instruction.

A 2024 school pilot program found that students receiving EMCDC outperformed non-pilot peers by up to 43 scale score points and gained up to 23.7 percentile points on national independent school benchmarks — with only 23 of the recommended 60 training hours.

Note on sharing: During the 2-day training, participants can share game materials. However, when working with students, it is most effective for each educator to have their own set.

4. Training Delivery & Logistics

Detail	Information
Format	Available online (live Zoom) or in person. Both formats deliver the full 2-day curriculum.
Recommended Duration	Two days is strongly recommended. A single-day session provides an introduction but does not allow full implementation training.
Group Size	Flexible — suitable for individual staff, small teams, or full district professional development days.
In-Person Travel Costs	For on-site training, travel expenses (hotel, meals, and mileage) are billed separately. Typical cost: \$900–\$1,000 for a two-day engagement.
Ongoing Support	EM in the Classroom recordings and the ROSES video library provide ongoing reference and support for trained staff after the initial PD.

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5. What Schools Can Expect

Schools that have implemented EMCDC consistently report outcomes beyond test scores. Educators notice changes in how students engage, focus, and carry themselves in the classroom.

Student Outcomes	Educator Observations
Improved working memory and ability to follow multi-step directions	Students redirect themselves more quickly and sustain focus longer
Faster processing speed, measurable within weeks of consistent training	Increased engagement and student confidence in academic tasks
Reading, spelling, and science gains confirmed by standardized assessment	Students describe sessions as 'fun' and 'helping me think better'
Gains in verbal reasoning, non-verbal reasoning, and IQ composite (KBIT-2) confirmed by independent researchers	Educators report seeing 'revelatory progress in students who have long struggled with down-scaled expectations'

★ **A Note on Implementation Intensity:** Research across all EMCDC studies confirms that consistent daily practice (5 days/week, 30 minutes) over a minimum of 60 hours produces the strongest outcomes. Partial participation yields partial results.
 The 2024 GFCS school pilot produced its results with only 23 hours — one-third of the recommended protocol. A full 60-hour implementation is expected to yield significantly stronger and more durable gains.
